

OLD TOWN PFLUGERVILLE

PROJECT PURPOSE

Over the next several months, from October through December, the Old Town Pflugerville Vision process will be occurring. Building upon previous planning efforts for Old Town, this process is intended to set a path toward consensus and action in a variety of potential areas related to the enhancement of Pflugerville's traditional downtown area. In addition to consultant findings and observations, the results will reflect a consolidation of input from all interested parties toward a consensus vision and action framework for the area, particularly for further consideration through the City's upcoming Comprehensive Plan Update process. It is expected that the results will be reported to the Planning & Zoning Commission and then City Council in January.

STAKEHOLDER FORUMS

Following an initial round of informal interviews (October 6-7), the City's consultant team (Kendig Keast Collaborative and José E. Martínez LLC) will facilitate a series of Stakeholder Forums. Through separate forums held over three evenings, the focus will be on the respective priorities, concerns and expectations of three key groups: commercial property owners (October 21), businesses (October 22), and neighborhood residents (October 23). Other groups and residents are welcome to attend any of these public sessions. Soon after, a combined forum will be conducted to confirm issues with substantial agreement or significant disagreement as a basis for determining what types of potential action strategies for downtown enhancement may enjoy the broadest community support.
